As a teen she crossed barriers by being a golfing talent that opened doors of mutual respect among genders. She has passed that same passion to her children and grandchildren. She influenced the personal growth and independence of hundreds of young women and girls through the LPGA-USGA Girls Golf program of Huntsville as its Director for 18 years. She recently gave up that position after finding security in the new Director. Beyond golf Marie's love of sport extended to softball, baseball, basketball, football, soccer, swimming, wrestling, and tennis; all of which her children were involved in.
